Applicants must be residents of Alberta, graduating from High School the year the Scholarship is awarded, and be entering one of the following programs;

- An Apprenticeship program
- A Trades program
- A post- secondary institution, college or university program

- 3. Working copy of most recent high school transcript.
- 4. An application essay, 400-500 words in length, on one of the Hall of Fame's inductees in the categories of Contestant, Builder or Legend, and why you admire them. Applicants must be willing to allow CRHA to publish their essay.
