Finalist Notes:

TIME LIMIT FOR ALL EVENTS:

A one minute time limit will be in effect from when the barrier is strung (roping and steer wrestling) or the contestant is "waved in" in the Barrel Racing, under judges stop watch & discretion.

Barrel Racing: At one minute contestant must mount a different horse or be flagged out.

Stock Timed Events: If animal is in standing position, a 30 second warning will be called. If contestant does not take their animal at the end of the 30 second warning they will be flagged out and fined, at judges discretion.

1st offence: \$50 fine

2nd Offence: \$100 fine

3rd Offence: \$150 fine

Each Additional Offences: \$200 fine

Finalist Apparel:

All contestants, while in or at the Silver Sage Community Corral, must either have their back number or CRA Finalist jacket visible, any contestant wearing any other association jacket or apparel in or at the Silver Sage Community Corral will be assessed a \$100 fine.
